	<p>At a Special Council Meeting on 26<sup>th</sup> October, the potential implications were considered after withdrawal from the European Union.</p> <p>LEADER funding has benefited rural areas of northern Ireland over the years. The Council has written to the European Union to request that it continues to fund any future LEADER programmes, and also to the Prime Minister seeking her commitment that any future LEADER funding will be supported from Westminster budgets.</p> <p>Fermanagh and Omagh District Council would appreciate the support of this Council in making similar representations.</p>
