Confidential report tabled, presented by the Director of Corporate Services, the purpose, for Council to consider a Governance issue which had arisen as an urgent matter which would require Council approval before Friday 14th December.

The recommendation before Council:

That Council Grants Delegated Authority to the Deputy Chief Executive to seek and obtain legal advice and to provide instructions to Council's legal representatives in the matter of an Application by James Hugh Allister and Robert Edwin Agnew for Judicial Review.

Council's Solicitor presented, verbally, Senior Counsel's Direction dated 11th December 2018 on the matter.

Members spoke to acknowledge the work done to date by officers following the recent developments in the Judicial Review proceedings. Council's Solicitor confirmed that Judicial Review proceedings would be elongated but it was not possible to predict an exact timescale.

Members also raised the matter of the increased workload for the Director of Corporate Services, other officers and Council's Solicitor. Members noted that additional resources would be sought for Council's Legal Department. The Director of Corporate Services advised that she would review the workload in Corporate Services and the level of resourcing required to deliver on a number of priority matters in the coming months.

In response to a query the Director of Corporate Services advised that the immediate priority was to deal with Court proceedings and that internal matters would be considered and addressed as required in due course.
