3.	The Regulation and Quality Improvement Authority	CONSULTATION ON PROPOSAL TO PUBLISH RQIA INSPECTION REPORTS RELATING TO CHILDRENS SERVICES	20th October 2022
<p>Summary</p> <p>At present, RQIA publishes inspection reports on website relating to services provided to adults, but does not publish those relating to Children’s Services. The current arrangement aims to protect the privacy of children and young people and to prevent attempts by anyone who would seek to target or exploit them. However, withholding publication of reports relating to services for children and young people prevents the wider public from having information about the quality of services being provided, and how they are functioning. Consultation proposes that these inspection reports are published in an anonymised format, which will protect the privacy of the children and young people who access these services.
