	<p>Cancellation was within 24hrs of the event which resulted in unavoidable and significant cost to Council.</p> <p>Total projected expenditure prior to event cancellation - £517,000</p> <p>Total projected income prior to event cancellation - £198,000</p> <p>Net cost to Council prior to event cancellation was projected at - £315,000</p> <p>Estimated net cost to Council following cancellation of event is circa. - £279,000</p> <p>All agency staff employed for the purposes of the Air Show ended a week after the event cancellation.</p>
