Before the Courtney McMullan Moycraig Young Farmers Club can adopt the kiosk, Ofcom obliges us to assess whether we may remove the payphone. We've followed the criteria in Ofcom's [Review of the telephony universal service obligation](#), which has shown that we can permanently remove the payphone service and that the adoption of the kiosk can go ahead.

We've put up a notice in the kiosk telling people about this plan.
