1.0 Purpose of Report

1.1 The purpose of this report is to seek Elected Member approval to increase the room hire charges in relation to the Civic Buildings. Rooms are available for hire in Sheskburn House, Ballymoney Town Hall, Coleraine Town Hall, Portrush Town Hall and Kilrea Town Hall. Rooms are not available for hire at Cloonavin, Riada House and the Limavady Offices.

2.0 Background

- 2.1 The cost of operating Buildings has increased particularly in relation to Staffing and Energy. Post Covid the rooms in Sheskburn House and the Town Halls were popular with community groups for meetings as the rooms enabled social distancing. No room hire charge increases were applied in 2023/24 to support those requiring this additional safe space.
- 2.2 The income and expenditure relating to the buildings that have rooms available for hire is listed below and covers the financial year 2022/2023. Sheskburn House is primarily used as staff office accommodation and is also a designated site for Registration Services.

- 2.3 It is the intention to bring back a report on the future use of the Civic Buildings to Council before the summer.
- 2.4 Elected Members are now asked to consider increasing the room hire charges in line with other Council facilities. The proposed increase is 8.5%. The impact of the proposed increase is detailed in Appendix 1.

3.0 Recommendation

It is recommended that the Council approve an increase of 8.5% on all room hire charges for Civic Buildings for 2024/25 as set out in Appendix 1.
