Notes on Applying for Consent to Display an Advertisement

1. The Law

Under the Planning (Control of Advertisements) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2015 certain outdoor advertisements require consent from the relevant Planning Authority before they can be displayed. Applicants should refer to the Regulations for details. It is a condition of the Regulations that before the advertisement to which the Consent relates is displayed, the permission of the owner of the land or building or other person(s) entitled to grant permission must be obtained.

2. Drawings Required

Include a site location plan to scale (preferably Ordnance Survey) which should be sufficient to enable the site to be easily identified. A site layout plan (scale 1:500) should be submitted for free standing advertisements.

The drawings submitted should be to scale and show:

- the size of the advertisement
- its position on the land or building in question
- the elevation of the building on which it is proposed to display an advertisement showing its relationship to adjoining buildings
- · design of lettering or emblem to be adopted
- height above ground
- · the materials to be used
- fixings
- colours
- the amount of projection (where it would project from a building)
- Photographs may be submitted.

 - Does the premises and its use have planning permission?
 - o Is the advertisement you are applying for already in place?
 - Does the application relate to the display of advertisement on the same land?
- Advertisement Period
 - o Is the application for consent to display an advertisement temporary in nature?

4. Fees
