Planning Application Accompanied by an Environmental Statement

**Application** No: LA01/2021/0175/F

**Location:** Land located at Smulgedon Hill, S of Legavallon Rd, approx. 9km to the N E of Dungiven & 8km W of Garvagh.

**Proposal:** Proposed amendments to the original consent B/2009/0070/F consisting of: - a reduction in the overall turbine tip height from 120.5m to 114.90m; a reduction in height from 85m to 68.9m & an increase in rotor diameter from 71m to 92m, for all 7 turbines - a new development site entrance; relocation of the combined substation & construction compound area; & a revised access track route to service T1, T2, T5 & T6 (as per previous consent B/2013/0196/f) - all ancillary development including minor increases in the size of the crane pads & wind turbine foundations to accommodate the newly proposed turbine models - The installed capacity will be 16.45MW.
