Location: Lands Approx 1.86km WSW of 175 Gelvin Rd, in the townlands of Brishey & Currgahlane, approx 4.8km E of Dungiven **Proposal**: Construction of a windfarm comprising up to 6no. turbines (to a maximum blade tip height of 150 metres) an electrical substation/control building, internal access tracks, spoil deposition areas, temporary construction compound, delivery route junction improvements & all associated ancillary works.
