LA01/2018/0200/F	Lands approx 6km N E of Limavady which are located immediately to the south of Broad Road (A37), in the Town land of Gortcorbies, Co Derry/ Londonderry. Access is provided directly from the Broad Road where an unoccupied stone building is located. The Western site boundary is located approx 1.2km east of Keady Hill Quarry and the eastern boundary is located approx 400m S W of disused quarry on Broad Road which is adjacent to Springfield Forest.	Construction of a wind farm comprising 9 no wind turbines (maximum 149.9m to blade tip) and associated infrastructure including internal electricity transformers, crane hard standings, underground cabling, control building, substation compound, energy storage area, newly created site entrance, new and upgraded on site access tracks, turning heads and all other associated ancillary works. During construction and commissioning there will be a number of temporary works including a construction compound with car parking, temporary parts of crane hard standing and welfare facilities.
