



## **Planning Act (Northern Ireland) 2011**

### **The Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2017**

The planning application reference LA01/2022/0981/F is accompanied by additional environmental information.

Causeway Coast and Glens Borough Council

**Application No.** LA01/2022/0981/F

**Location:** Lands approximately 6km NE of Limavady accessed off the Broad Rd in the townland of Gortcorbies Co Derry/Londonderry

**Proposal:** Proposed amendment to the previously consented Dunbeg South Wind Farm (LA01/2018/0200/F) - Construction of wind farm comprising 9 No. wind turbines (maximum 149.9 metres to blade tip) & associated infrastructure including external electricity transformers, crane hardstandings, underground cabling, control building, substation compound, newly created site entrance, new & upgraded on-site access tracks, turning heads & all other associated ancillary works. During construction & commissioning there will be a number of temporary works including a construction compound with car parking, temporary parts of crane hardstanding & welfare facilities. This amendment is to include an alternative turbine model increasing the rotor diameters up to a maximum of 117m & retaining a hub height up to a maximum of 100m. The overall tip height of the turbines shall remain at the previously consented 149.9m.
