LA01/2016/0061/F	On lands directly of A37/ Broad Rd, to the E of 156 Broad Road and to the W of the operational Dunbeg Windfarm, in the townland of Dunbeg, Limavady.	Construct a three turbine extension to the operational Dunbeg Wind Farm (consented under PAC REF. 2009/A0363 to planning reference B/2007/0560/F), each turbine will have a Hub Height not exceeding 84m and Blade Diameter not exceeding 82m, associated access tracks, underground cabling, temporary construction compound, upgrade and widening of an existing site entrance off the A37, forestry felling (approximately 1.36ha) and all associated works.
