<b>1</b>	<b>Department for Infrastructure – Proposed Waiting Restrictions, Strand Road, Coleraine (received 20 August 2018)</b>
	<p>Correspondence has been received from the Department for Infrastructure (DfI) who are considering altering the waiting restrictions on the Strand Road, Coleraine, to allow traffic to use the 2 lanes throughout the working day. This will improve the time taken for traffic to progress through the Waterside Gyratory.</p> <p>The existing waiting restriction operates from Monday to Saturday between the times of 8:00am and 9:30am. The proposed restriction operates from Monday to Saturday between the times of 8:00am and 5:30am.</p> <p>Before proceeding with the drafting of the legislation the DfI would like to receive any comments from Council regarding this proposal.</p>
<b>2</b>	<b>Department for Infrastructure – Proposed Waiting Restrictions, Mountsandel Road, Coleraine (received 20 August 2018)</b>
	<p>The Department for Infrastructure has received a number of complaints concerning parked vehicles on the Mountsandel Road, Coleraine, between Terrace Row and the old hospital site. These vehicles are hindering traffic progression and also restricting visibility from various accesses.</p> <p>To address these issues, DfI Roads is proposing to introduce waiting restrictions Monday to Saturday, 8:00am to 5:30pm, along the lengths of Mountsandel Road.</p>
