	<p>A consultation has been received on Code of Conduct for Local Government employees. The Commission wishes to consult with councils, the NIHE and other key stakeholders on a revised Code of Conduct which was developed by a Working Group, comprising representatives from the Councils, NIHE, the Department for Communities and the Trade Unions.</p> <p>The amendments to the Code have been made to take account of best practice, examples of similar Codes of Conduct in other public sector bodies and issues that councils have encountered in operating the current Code.</p> <p>When the consultation closes, the Working Group will meet to consider the responses received. The final amended Code of Conduct for Local Government Employees will then be approved by the Commission before being issued in September 2020 as a statutory recommendation to Councils for implementation by 1<sup>st</sup> October 2020.</p>
