1.0 Purpose of Report

- 1.1 Permission sought to extend contract for the collection, disposal and treatment of engine oil, oily rags, oil filters, vegetable oil, paints, varnishes and used engine oil containers. Contract was procured by North West Region Waste Management Group (NWRWVG) on behalf of its constituent Councils. Current service provider is Enva Ltd.
- 1.2 Extension period is for a further 12 months, commencing 1st February 2020.
- 1.3 Price per tonne tendered will be unchanged.

2.0 Background (to include any previous decisions of Council)

- 2.1 Initial contract period was for three years, commencing 1st February 2017 and terminating 31st January 2020.
- 2.2 Initial contract approved by Council in March 2017.

3.0 Recommendation(s)

It is recommended that the Environmental Services Committee recommends to Council the extension of the contract for the collection, disposal and treatment of engine oil, oily rags, oil filters, vegetable oil, paints, varnishes and used engine oil containers for a further 12 months.
