CROSS BOUNDARY APPLICATION

Planning Application: LA01/2023/0348/F

Location: Cloughmills Central Substation approx. 175m North of 36 Drumadoon Road, Cloughmills to existing pole 45/229 approx. 75m North East of 107 Ballyemon Road, Cushendall

Proposal: An 11kv system reinforcement from Cloughmills central substation to existing pole 45/229. This new proposal runs through two council boundaries - Causeway Coast and Glens and Mid and East Antrim. The proposal starts in CCG from Cloughmills Central Substation to pole 4007, it then transfers over M&EA from pole 4008 to 4173. The line then transfers back into CCG from 4174 to existing pole 45/229. There are two underground cable sections - one from Cloughmills Central Substation to pole 4000 and the other from 4180 to 111/229, both in CCG.

A cross boundary planning application has been received by both Mid and East Antrim Borough Council and Causeway Coast and Glens Borough Council by NIE for an 11kv overhead line from Cloughmills to Cushendall.

Causeway Coast and Glens Borough Council has discharged its planning functions for this application to Mid and East Antrim Borough Council. This will allow Mid and East Antrim Borough Council to process the entire scheme. Causeway Coast and Glens Borough Council will be consulted on the determination of the application.
