STATEMENT FOR PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER

BACKBURN PATH

PATH LINKING IRISH GREEN STREET AND BACKBURN PARK, LIMAVADY

Causeway Coast & Glens Borough Council proposes to confirm a public path extinguishment order under the Access to the Countryside (Northern Ireland) Order 1983 Article 14.

Causeway Coast & Glens Borough Councils Leisure & Development Committee took this decision at their meeting on 20 June 2023 after receiving a request from the Education Authority formally requesting that Council considers making a Public Path Order to extinguish the path to facilitate the development of the Limavady Shared Education Campus. The existence of the path would require the continued fencing within the campus which is not considered conducive to the campus concept. (letter attached at **Appendix 1**)

After considering the request, Causeway Coast & Glens Borough Council, took the decision to start proceeding to close the pathway through a Public Path Extinguishment Order.

Path marked A-B and coloured brown – Path linking Irish Green Street and Backburn Park, Limavady

Pathway to be extinguished from Irish Green Street (IGR: C 67226 22741) to Blackburn Park (IGR: C 67423 22836) between St Mary's Limavady, 72-90, Irish Green Street, Limavady, County Londonderry and Limavady High School, Connell Street, Limavady, County Londonderry.
