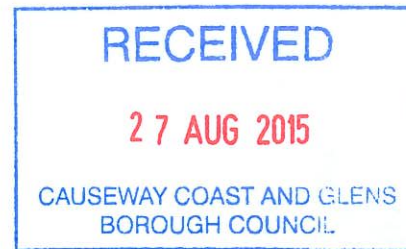




Limavady Rotary Club

Dear Sir,

Over the past five years the Rotary Club in Limavady has in cooperation with the Council raised money for distribution to local people in need. The club have done this by manning and selling to the public from the town Christmas tree yellow ribbons, on which a personal message of remembrance can be written. The ribbons are attached to the tree over the Christmas period and then removed for dedication at an ecumenical service in a local church.

The money raised is equally divided between the Salvation Army and St Vincent de Paul for local distribution and over the past years the money raised is in excess of £20,000.

The council have in the past been very supportive of our efforts allowing use of the tree, and facilitating the overall operation over the two week Christmas period.

I would on behalf of the Club ask that we have permission to once again man the tree and hopefully raise money for the charities in what has become a "tradition" in the town.
