3. Consultation on Proposed Consolidated Water Framework Directive Priority Substances and Classifications Regulations

The primary purpose of and driver behind the Regulations is to transpose Directive 2013/39/EU on priority substances in the field of water policy. Thirty- three substances were listed in the original Priority Substances Directive (2008/205/EC). This was reviewed by the European Commission in 2013 and led to the adoption of the Directive 2013/39/EU which revised a number of environmental standards for some current substances and added a further twelve additional substances to the original list.

The Department is required to transpose this Directive by 14th September 2015 and intends to do this by making a new set of Regulations which incorporate key elements of both the 2008 and 2013 Directives and consolidate the current domestic legislation in respect of priority substances and WFD Classifications.
