This structure is typical of the style, size and construction of many small rural lime kilns. Its fabric is original, intact and in reasonable repair. Prior to the advent of cement and artificial fertilisers, it would have been of considerable economic value to the local community in producing burnt lime for use as fertilizer, building mortar and whitewash. It is also of local interest, and has group value with a secondlime kiln, located along Murlough Road within the townland of 'Bighouse', which is of similar age, materials and construction.	1880 - 1899
