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An arrangement whereby businesses get together, decide what additional improvements they want to make, how they are going to manage and deliver those improvements and what it will cost them. This all goes into a business plan which is voted on by all those who would have to pay. The BID can last for a maximum of 5 years and must be able to demonstrate how it has benefited businesses who have funded it.



HOW LONG DOES A BID TAKE?

A BID normally takes between 12 and 18 months to develop.

3 Stage Process

Feasibility Stage ► months 0-3
Development Stage ► months 4-12
Campaign Stage ► months 13-15

The process is governed by the NI BIDs legislation introduced here in July 2014.

WHAT IS THE BID BUSINESS PLAN?

The BID Business Plan is the final document that has collected all the ideas and suggestions from businesses through the development phase. The Plan is the basis upon which voters are asked to make their decision on supporting the BID.

WHAT IS THE BID BALLOT?

Each business property in the BID area has a vote. The vote is a simple yes or no based on the content of the BID Business Plan. For the ballot to be valid there must be at least a 25% turnout of voters. There must be a majority yes vote by number and a majority yes by **Rateable Value**.

HOW ARE BIDS FINANCED?

BIDs are financed by a levy on the Rateable Value of business

premises in the BID area. The levy is usually around 1% - 2% of the RV. If the BID ballot is successful payment is mandatory for all eligible businesses in the BID area.

Rateable Value	BID Levy (1.5%/pa)
£5,000	£75
£10,000	£150
£25,000	£325
£50,000	£750
£100,000	£1,500

HOW LONG DO BIDS LAST?

A BID can last for a maximum of 5 years and must be able to demonstrate how it has benefited businesses who have funded it. After 5 years, the BID area must go through the re-ballot process before it can continue running.

HOW ARE BIDS MANAGED?

During the development process the BID is driven and managed by interested volunteers from local businesses and stakeholders called a **BID Task Group**. Once the Ballot is successful the delivery of the BID Plan will be managed by a **BID Company**. The Company is usually set up as a not for profit company limited by guarantee. The Company will be made up of a **Board of Directors** elected from company members and be representative of the business sectors in the BID area. The Company will normally employ **staff** to deliver the actions in the **BID Plan**.


