Antrim		B1	Detached three-bay, direct entry, single- storey rubblestone vernacular house and outbuildings built pre 1832 located in an isolated rural landscape on the banks of Glendun River in the Glens of Antrim. The grouping consists of a dwelling and associated outbuildings, forming a distinct collection of vernacular structures. The dwelling itself retains much external historic fabric such as a natural slate roof, timber sliding sash windows and a central windbreak entrance porch, retaining the character and appearance of the once dominant type of dwelling in rural Ireland. It now stands as an increasingly rare example of its type that once characterised the local area. Its interest is enhanced by its fine relatively unaltered rural setting.	1820 - 1839
