The cabin at Coleraine Station (HB03/020/001B) is similar.</p> <p>Although recently refurbished, some original character survives, notably the deep eaves, timber-framed FF, and external staircase (albeit a replacement). Standard layout with signal levers at FF level, and lever connections to linking rods on GF. The hand-operated levers are now a rare survival of national interest as most other cabins on Translink's network have been automated.</p> <p>The cabin survives in its original setting at the S end of the station and also has group value with the station building (HB03/010/003A) and water tower (HB03/010/003C).</p>	1880 - 1899

STATUTORY LIST OF BUILDINGS OF SPECIAL ARCHITECTURAL OR HISTORIC INTEREST

WHEREAS

1. by section 80 of the Planning Act (Northern Ireland) 2011 the Department for Communities (hereinafter called "the Department") is required to compile lists of buildings of special architectural or historic interest;
2. it appears to the Department that the buildings described in the attached Schedule are buildings of special architectural or historic interest;
3. the Department has consulted with the Historic Buildings Council and Causeway Coast and Glens Borough Council.

NOW THEREFORE the Department in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 80 of the Planning Act (Northern Ireland) 2011 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby includes on the list of buildings of special architectural or historic interest the building/s set out in the attached schedule.
