Its historical interest is enhanced by the presence of its maker's name and date. The addition mid-century of a second tank reflects the number of steam trains using the station in the mid-1900s, immediately prior to their replacement with diesel engines. Though one tank has been removed in recent years, the fact that the original tank remains and that it is still working is also of interest.</p> <p>The tank survives in its original setting at the S end of the station and also has group value with the station building (HB03/010/003A) and signal box and nearby signals (HB03/010/003B).</p>	1880 - 1899


STATUTORY LIST OF BUILDINGS OF SPECIAL ARCHITECTURAL OR HISTORIC INTEREST

WHEREAS

1. by section 80 of the Planning Act (Northern Ireland) 2011 the Department for Communities (hereinafter called "the Department") is required to compile lists of buildings of special architectural or historic interest;
2. it appears to the Department that the buildings described in the attached Schedule are buildings of special architectural or historic interest;
3. the Department has consulted with the Historic Buildings Council and Causeway Coast and Glens Borough Council.

NOW THEREFORE the Department in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 80 of the Planning Act (Northern Ireland) 2011 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby includes on the list of buildings of special architectural or historic interest the building/s set out in the attached schedule.
